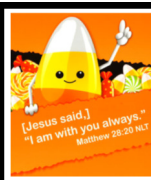

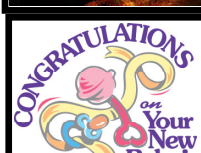
TIME CHANGE
